OUR STORY:

As young children born in the Soviet Union, the life Henry and Olga would once have together was unimaginable. They traveled halfway across the world to find each other, and here in the states they started a family. For years, they would come to the Napa Valley with the best of friends and family, celebrating all the wonder that life had to offer. Slowly, the allure of wine country overtook them. They had a dream...

In 2007, Henry and Olga stumbled upon a place called Terra Del Cuore, and they knew that it would be the home for their vineyard. Together with their three sons, they founded Patland Estate Vineyards. Combining their estate fruit with that of renown Stagecoach Vineyard, Patland is producing some of the finest wine to come out of the Napa Valley today.

WINEMAKERS'S NOTES:

If you've come looking for the bright, red cherry aromas of your favorite Sonoma Coast Pinot Noir, you've come to the wrong place. This wine is so intense in its black cherry and bramble that it could lead wine's goth movement. While the wine is restrained at first, it's clear from the deep ruby color, chalky tannin and black-as-your-soul fruit that this wine is incredibly extracted and concentrated. Given a couple hours to breath, the wine seriously opens up and the aromas become increasingly more high-toned. This wine will certainly benefit from decanting and will surely go the distance of ten years, if not more. On the palate, the wine is more classic with flavors of earthy terroir, nutrient-rich soil and porcini mushroom.



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
