WINEMAKER'S NOTES:

Dark garnet hue; Bright black cherry, anise, black pepper, mocha, sage, boysenberry, cigar spice, and caramelized new French oak. Expect a full and plush mid palate density with layered flavors of blackberry, tobacco, cedar spice, raspberry, dried sage, integrated toasty oak and creamy chocolate. The persistent yet balanced finish exhibits excellent depth, purity, and elegance.
