Opens with bright raspberry, perfumed cherry, orange peel, jasmine, jolly rancher, and a hint vanilla frosting. Expect a crisp and polished rich palate with layered flavors of ripe plum, kiwi strawberry, roasted marshmallow, tart cherry pie, honey, and mixed red berry finishing with vibrant acidity.
