WINEMAKER'S NOTES:

While late harvested Syrah is the backbone of this Vintage Port, there is also a special component used to fortify this black nectar. This other part is ultra premium brandy, distilled by seventh generation Cognac master distiller Hubert Germain-Robin. The result of marrying these two liquid gems together at just the right time has produced an unctuous, inky, ultra ripe, opulent port with intense black fruit and dark chocolate flavors woven together by super rich velvety tannins. The mouth-feel and finish of this Vintage Port lasts for over 120 seconds, and this wine will continue to unfold for more than 50 years!

OUR STORY:

As young children born in the Soviet Union, the life Henry and Olga would once have together was unimaginable.
