Inky black in color. Crème Brulee, ripe blackberry, orange peel, boysenberry, anise and cinnamon spice excite the senses. Subtle flavors of chocolate, blueberry pie, brandied cherries, orange marmalade, baker’s chocolate and fig compote flood the mouth coating unctuous palate.
