WINEMAKER'S NOTES:

This wine starts with medium intensity on the nose, opening with refreshing spearmint and leading quickly into a fresh medley of tropical and citrus fruit. Aromas of jasmine, fruit cake, yellow plum and pineapple juice, and then flavors of ruby red grapefruit and kiwi on the palate. Everything culminates in a near-creamy vanilla flavor and a long finish of bright acidity. Perfect to pair with your favorite soft cheese or brie!
